Project Title: PW Large Trucks Program Area: Vehicles/Equipment

Project Description:

This is a CNR Fund 6 sinking fund to provide for a long-term regular replacement plan for the 10-Ton Dump Trucks for the Public Works Department.

Evaluation Category: SR

Planning Context:

This account needs to be funded annually to meet long-term replacement needs of the large dump truck fleet. Originally, funding was sought to meet a 15-year replacement cycle for each of the trucks in the fleet. Because of severe funding constraints, measures have been implemented to extend this to 25 years. A washbay has been constructed to increase frequency and effectiveness of concerted cleaning efforts. Additionally, selective refurbishment has been implemented to extend life cycles. The next purchase is scheduled for FY12.

Schedule: On-going program through which funds are expended for dump trucks acquired in accordance with a replacement plan that is updated as necessary to address operational and material conditions.

Previous Town Meeting Action: Sinking fund has been approved as part of the Town budget since FY98.
