The Permanent Commission for Senior Citizens unanimously endorses the \$27, 000 for replacement windows and \$10,000 for carpet replacement.

The windows are rotting due to the lack of gutters on the building. Gutters have been installed on the Senior Center this past June, eliminating the water runoff problem. Also the carpet is the original carpeting since 1993. The nap of the carpeting has worn down considerably causing it to be a hazard to many seniors, especially those with walkers.
