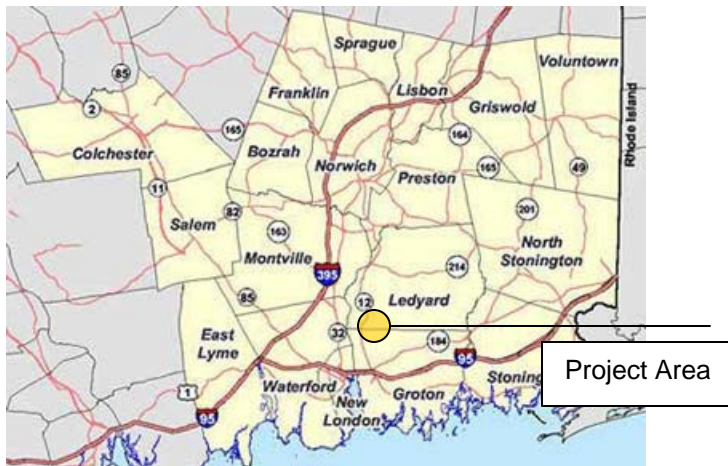

Groton-Ledyard Wastewater Interconnection

- Considering the construction of a publicly funded Industrial Park
- Infrastructure improvements would include road improvements, extension of water and sewer mains
- Extension of water main is currently possible under existing permits
- Additional permitting and agreements necessary for sewer main extension
- Additional planning and permitting will be required to gain approval for funding and construction of Phase 1 of the Park

Groton-Ledyard Wastewater Interconnection

- Ledyard is in the process of finishing a sewer feasibility study for the Industrial Park
- Preferred alternative will recommend an interconnection with Groton Wastewater Treatment Facilities
- Ledyard made a request to Groton Town Council for a policy determination on an interconnection
- Interconnection request was referred to Groton Water Pollution Control Authority
- Ledyard is requesting an initial 50,000 gpd in wastewater treatment capacity be reserved for Phase 1 of the Industrial Park
- Ledyard could contribute to resolving I&I problems elsewhere in the system to balance the change in wastewater flows
